Buying shoes or sun glasses? Now you can *B.O.A.W.G.O.A.F....

On holiday in 2006 in Argentina, Blake Mycoskie, then a software entrepreneur, grew to love the local alpargata shoes, (like espadrilles), made of canvas wrapped round a rope sole. Then he was invited to go with some folks from a charity who were giving away shoes there, which they had collected at home in the US, and he was shocked to see injured feet on children who had no shoes to walk miles to school.

Blake’s **BIG IDEA** was born, and he ordered 250 pairs of alpargatas, selling them in the US on the promise that, *for every pair he sold, he would give away a pair of new shoes for a child in need.* This simple, big-hearted, idea caught with some celeb’s and, to date, [TOMS](#) has *given away more than 10,000,000 pairs of shoes*, and, in a similar scheme for sunglasses, has *given sight-restoring eye surgery or treatment to over 200,000 people.*
