# **The Aust Pilgrimage**

*The pilgrimage commemorates St Augustine's journey to meet the Welsh bishops on the banks of the River Severn in 603. He intended to sort out differences between the Roman and Celtic Churches. This encounter did not lead to reconciliation, but it did pave the way for the Synod of Whitby, 61 years later, when agreement was reached.*

### **The Pilgrimage Route**

<b>8.00am</b>	short service in Bristol Cathedral after which pilgrims leave through the Cloister Car park.	<b>1.00pm</b>	half-hour break for refreshment Picnic lunch beside Bristol-Cardiff railway, Ash Lane, Cattybrook
<b>9.15am</b>	arrive at Fairfields School off Muller Road		
<b>9.35am</b>	arrive at the BT Tower on Purdown	<b>4.00pm</b>	Reach Aust. Refreshment in the Church or at the Boar's Head
<b>10.30am</b>	arrive at Parkway Station		
<b>11.45am</b>	arrive at Church of the Holy Family, Highwood Rd, Patchway	<b>5.00pm</b>	Pilgrimage Service in St John's Church Aust

*There will be prayer stations at various points during the day*

*You may join the Pilgrimage anywhere along the route but do remember that these timings are approximate.*

*Also please give some thought as to how you will return home from Aust. Although we will try to help with lifts back to Bristol, we cannot guarantee that there will be people present who will have car places available.*
