The Aust Pilgrimage Saturday 26th May 2018



From Bristol Cathedral to the Banks of the Severn



The pilgrimage commemorates St Augustine's journey to meet the Welsh bishops on the banks of the River Severn in 603. He intended to sort out differences between the Roman and Celtic Churches. This encounter did not lead to reconciliation, but it did pave the way for the Synod of Whitby, 61 years later, when agreement was reached.
