Job title:	Families Outreach Worker
Location	FBC and within the community
Commitment/hours	Up to 16 hours per week Due to the nature of the post, the position will require some weekend and some evening work.
Salary (pro rata)	£9,100

JOB PURPOSE

- Work closely with parents and careers who attend church activities, particularly those who
 are new to the church, sharing our beliefs and demonstrating our Christian faith
- Work alongside our established, church-based, toddler group leadership teams
- Lead and develop Messy Church (currently held monthly)
- Visit families in the community who are new attendees of FBC or who need support

KEY RELATIONSHIPS

- Senior Minister (line manager)
- The toddler group leadership team
- Youth and Children's Worker
- Sticky Fish day nursery
- Accountable to deacons on behalf of FBC

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support parents and carers who attend our three toddler groups and other church activities.
- Provide opportunities for all who attend to grow in their understanding and experience of the Christian faith.
- Visit parents and carers who attend our groups, as well as families who are new to the church.
- Provide oversight, leadership and further development of Messy Church. This includes supporting the team of volunteers.
- Facilitate day time groups such as Alpha, Christianity Explored or a small group / Bible study group for parents.
- Deliver courses such as parenting skills.
- Provide input into the occasional Sticky Fish church services.
- Work closely with the Youth & Children's Worker.
- Contribute to some Sunday morning services and be visible within the wider church eg providing updates and prayer, children's talks
- Attend Church Members' meetings with the occasional presentation of reports.
- Manage within budgetary constraints

- To have a portfolio of relevant experience, especially Christian evangelism.
- To be passionate about sharing the love of Jesus with children and families and developing the faith of those you have contact with
- A deep grounding in Christian faith
- Enhanced DBS to work with children and vulnerable adults

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, including listening skills
- To be fully aligned to FBC'S values and ethos and attend Sunday morning worship
- Highly developed organisational skills and the ability to prioritise work and manage within budgetary constraints
- To be able to contribute to the leadership team
- To be able to work independently and collaboratively, being able to show initiative and the ability to develop new ideas in a sustainable way
- To be able to show innovation and have a pioneering instinct

- To have experience of public speaking.
- To hold a full driving licence.
- To be willing to consider church membership
