

6. **Bus:** First Bus - Bus stop is approximately a 15 minute walk away from the venue. You can also catch the 24 (to Ashton Gate) bus which will drop you off at Lawrence Hill the venue is a 15 minute walk, across the roundabout.

7. **Train:** The closest train station is Bristol Temple Meads – you can catch the number 8/9/70/71 bus which will drop you off in the city centre. Then you either get a taxi or a number 24 bus to Ashton Gate) which will drop you off at Lawrence Hill, the venue is a 15 minute walk, across the roundabout.
