LAY WORKER TO SUPPORT MINISTER IN SOUTH BRISTOL METHODIST CHURCH (SBMC)

A post is available for a part time lay worker for South Bristol Methodist Church (SBMC) to supplement the work of the minister in pastoral charge.

Part time: 17.5 hours per week (half time appointment)

A fixed appointment of 12 months from the start date.

The post is subject to an occupational requirement that the holder be a committed Christian under Part 1 of Schedule 9 to the Equality Act 2010.

The person appointed will:

- Undertake pastoral work in the congregations alongside the minister.
- Work as part of a team with the minister and others to offer nurture groups/Alpha courses, Bible studies and other opportunities for learning in the church.
- Lead/co-lead regular services in care homes.
- If suitably qualified, lead/co-lead worship services on Sundays in the churches.
- Work as part of a team with the minister, other lay staff and church members to help the church move forward in its mission.
- Attend SBMC Leadership Team and Church Council Meetings.
- Ensure that all Safeguarding protocols are followed.
- Meet regularly with the minister to review the progress and direction of the work.
- Attend other church meetings as required.

Support for the role:

- To meet, pray and discuss the development of the role with the minister each month and communicate in between
- To have Supervision, in line with Connexional policy for those in pastoral ministry roles

Person specification

Essential:

- Self-motivated, well organised, a good communicator
- Pastoral skills
- Ability to lead small groups for discussion and Bible study
- Able to relate to church members and others, encourage good use of local talents and build good relationships
- Able to work as part of a team
- Good IT and administrative skills
- Willing to keep learning and growing in faith
- A heart for sharing the gospel with others in appropriate ways
- Sympathy with the aims and values of the Methodist Church

Desirable but not essential:

- Experience of working with older people
- Mental Health First Aid training and experience of working with people suffering from mental ill health.
- Experience of leading worship and preaching (local preacher or worship leader in the Methodist Church or equivalent)
